

ANYONE OBSERVING ANY OF THESE CONDITIONS MUST IMMEDIATELY



- Allergic reaction (especially if there is any difficulty breathing)
- Difficulty breathing (especially that does not improve with rest)
- Choking
- Chest pain
- Someone is faint/passes out, or is unresponsive (comatose)
- Difficulty speaking, numbness, or weakness of any part of the body, or sudden mental confusion
- Sudden blindness or vision changes
- Bleeding from any wound that won't stop with direct pressure
- Broken bone
- Severe burn
- Sudden intense severe pain
- Someone is threatening to hurt themselves or others (including death threats) - ask for both EMS and NYPD

Staff observing any of these conditions must immediately call 911.

Guests and 14Y Members observing any of these conditions must alert a 14Y staff member.
