OUR PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

PRIDE SITE - RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT

Our residential therapeutic community provides evidence-based clinical services at all points of recovery. Residential programs include individual and group psychotherapy, case management, medication management and assessment, and vocational services, and wellness activities.

PROJECT CONTACT - OUTPATIENT TREATMENT

Our comprehensive outpatient services include substance use disorder treatment for individuals, families, and significant others, all delivered in a safe and supportive environment that nurtures the whole person. We strive to provide clients with the tools they need for long-term recovery, offering high quality client-centered treatment, psychiatric assessments, medication management, individual and group therapy, all with individualized treatment plans during the day and in the evenings. We recognize that families play an integral role in recovery and are committed to supporting family members who have been impacted by a loved one's substance use disorder.

PROJECT HELP - PREVENTION EDUCATION

We offer a broad range of evidence-based substance abuse prevention education services that reinforce self-esteem and empower youth, adults and families to make healthy decisions. We offer developmentally-appropriate extended prevention programs that give youth and their families the tools and knowledge necessary to avoid substance abuse, improve communication and enhance overall well-being. In addition, we provide training for service providers such as teachers, counselors and other professionals, equipping them with effective solutions for recognizing and addressing substance use and abuse among their client populations.

RECOVERY SERVICES and COMMUNITY PROGRAMS

We are committed to empowering each individual we serve to find sustained recovery from addiction. Our Center offers a safe space to socialize and meet other sober people in the community.
